Law Enforcement Alert for Victims of Identity Theft

Submit in person: At any driver exam station, or driver's license office that accepts driver's license applications.

- Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) recognizes that the misuse of your identity by someone else is a serious problem. When you submit the completed form, an entry will be made on your driver record to alert law enforcement officers that someone else may be using your identity. This entry should prevent someone from using your name when involved with law enforcement.
• It is important for you to know that this entry may cause you inconvenience if you have contact with law enforcement personnel as they will specifically request your identification. For your own protection, we recommend you always have your Minnesota driver's license or identification card with you.
• To help prevent identity theft, you will be required to take a new photo each time you complete an in-office transaction with DVS.
• This form will not prevent someone else from using your name in financial matters, such as establishing credit or other accounts.

What is the reason for collecting the requested personal information?

Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) collects the information on this form for identification purposes. This information will be used to add an entry to your driver record to alert law enforcement officers that someone else may be using your identity.

Am I required to provide the requested personal information?

You are not legally required to complete this form and provide the personal information.

What will happen if I do not provide the requested personal information?

If you do not provide the information, DVS cannot complete your request to add an entry to your driver record to alert law enforcement officers that someone else may be using your identity.

Who will have access to the requested personal information?

DVS may disclose the collected personal information in response to searches regarding the operation or use of a motor vehicle, or when required to protect public safety. The use of personal information to protect public safety occurs when the physical safety or security of drivers, vehicles, pedestrians or property is put at risk. The personal information you provide is classified by 18 U.S.C. section 2721 and Minn. Stat. section 171.12, and the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act and is subject to disclosure in accordance with these laws. The personal information may also be disclosed pursuant to a court order if requested by the state or legislative auditor.

I request that an entry be placed on my driving record to alert law enforcement personnel that someone else may be using my identity. I understand that this entry will remain on my record until I send a written request to DVS to remove it.

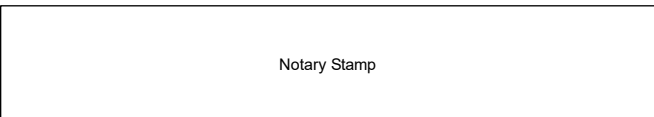
