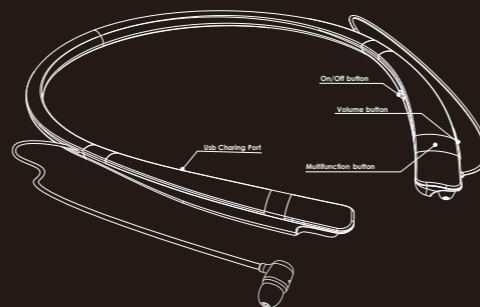

PRODUCT INDICATION



1

PAIRING STEPS

1. Toggle Power On/Off Button to "ON", press and hold the Multifunction Button about 4 seconds, the indicator light flashes in Red-Blue blinking.
2. Turn on your phone's or other pairing devices' Bluetooth function.
3. Search Bluetooth devices and select "COULAX CX04" on your phone (Enter passcode 0000 if needed).

Pairing successful: the indicator light will slowly flash in blue.

Pairing failed: power off the headset, and repeat the above steps.

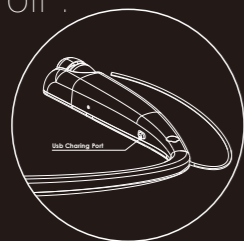
Automatic connect: the headset will pair the last connected device automatically when it turns on.

ON/OFF BUTTON

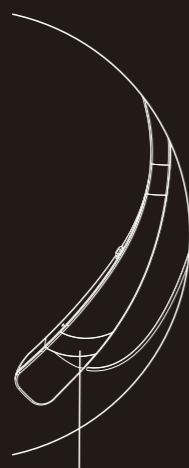
Toggle On/Off Button to power to "On", the indicator light turns blue with a voice prompting "Power On".

Toggle On/Off Button to power to "Off", the indicator light turns red with a voice prompting "Power Off".

Multifunction Button

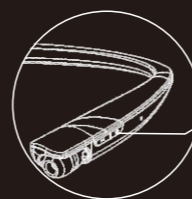
Press to Answer/Reject a call. (Play/Pause music)

Press and hold 2 seconds to reject a call

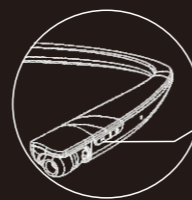
Double press to redial the last called number

Volume up / Next song: short / long press the "+" button.

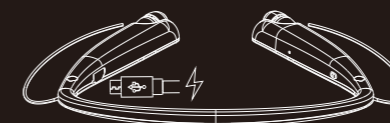


Volume down / Previous song: short / long press the "-" button.
