

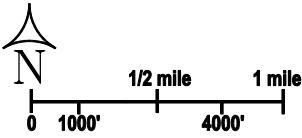
Key

These are off-street trails which are for multiple types of users including walkers, joggers, runners, in-line skaters, and cyclists of all skill levels. Caution should be used when the multi-use trails intersect with roadways and driveways.
- On-street Bike Lane

Cyclists using bicycle lanes should have some experience and comfort level cycling on-street. Cyclists will need to follow all appropriate rules of the road. Cyclists are likely to encounter stop lights and/or stop signs and should use proper lane positioning so motorists can see you.
- - - Shared Road Designation

Cyclists using these roads should be experienced and confident cycling on-street with traffic. Cyclists will likely encounter stop lights and/or stop signs and may experience moderate to heavy traffic during the peak travel times. Cyclists should ride predictably and use proper lane positioning when turning or traveling through intersections as well as follow the rules of the road.
